Dear Graduates and Graduate Candidates:

We are pleased that you will be able to attend the **2024 Okinawa Commencement**, which will be held on **Saturday, April 13, 2024 at 2:00pm, at the Yomitan Cultural Center in Yomitan, Okinawa, Japan**. We are looking forward to sharing this memorable occasion with you, your family, and your guests.

The Schedule of Events for the day of commencement is as follows:

9:30am – 12:00pm	Graduate Check-in and Line-up : Graduates assemble at the student area to check-in and robe. There will be signs indicating assembly areas and graduate marshals will also be available for assistance.
9:30am - 12:00pm	Commencement Portraits : Please stop by to have your graduation photos taken in your regalia by a professional photographer. Your family members are more than welcome to have their photos taken as well. The cost of the photos is based on vendor pricing.
12:00pm – 1:30pm	Pre-processional & Dress Rehearsal : Graduates will go through a practice run of the processional and recessional in full regalia along with a briefing concerning the graduation ceremony. Please have your gown out of the packaging and steamed free of wrinkles prior to the ceremony. After the practice run, graduates will immediately reassemble at the check-in location until the processional begins.
1:30pm - 2:00pm	Guest Seating : Doors will be open for guest seating at 1:30pm. Due to space limitations, you may bring up to four guests. Children are welcome but if your child becomes restless, please take them to the separate room designated for this purpose.
2:00pm	Processional begins : Graduates will march from the formation area to the main hall, followed by faculty and the platform party.
3:30pm - 6:00pm	Post-Commencement Reception : A reception honoring the graduates will be held shortly after the commencement ceremony concludes.
3:30pm-5:00pm	Post-Commencement Portraits: Time for graduates and their families to sit for portraits with a professional photographer. The cost of the photos is based on vendor pricing.

RSVP: Please confirm if you plan to attend the ceremony via the unique link sent to you via email. If you haven't received your link by March 1, 2024, email commencement-asia@umgc.edu.

Regalia and Commencement Invitations: You must order your **commencement regalia (cap and gown)** through Oak Hall no later **than March 16** to allow time for shipping. No regalia will available for rental or purchase on the day of the event. Shipping to an APO/FPO address is considered domestic shipping (not international, even if the location is outside of the USA).

If you would like to order **commencement invitations**, you can order official UMGC Asia invitations at: https://www.cbgrad.com/. When you enter the ordering portal, select "state," "school," and "month" of ceremony to get started. Please choose "Maryland" as the state, "University of Maryland Global Campus Asia" as the school and "April" as the month of the ceremony. Then click on "Get Started."

Dress Code: All graduates are required to wear regalia (graduation cap and gown) to commencement. We encourage you to wear appropriate business casual attire under your gown. We recommend comfortable shoes because there will be prolonged periods of standing and walking throughout the day. Guests are not permitted to accompany graduates to the robing area. Note that Graduates are not permitted to have any items -- purses, cameras, cell phones, etc.-- in their hands when they line-up and the graduation gowns do not have pockets. Please leave all items with your guest, or in your car or room. Please be sure to remove your gown from the packing material and hang it to remove wrinkles prior to the ceremony day. We recommend that you STEAM your gown to remove creases and wrinkles. Use care with irons since a hot iron can burn the fabric easily.

Guests: Due to space constraints, each graduate may have up to 4 guests attend the ceremony. Children are welcome at the ceremony but to maintain the formal atmosphere, please take restless children to the separate room we have for this purpose.

Parking at the Yomitan Cultural Center: There is free parking at the location.

Eligibility for Graduation

Students who have graduated in Summer 2023, Fall 2023, or Winter 2024 (MBA and MSTL only) with an associate's degree or higher are automatically eligible to attend this year's commencement and will receive an invitation to attend the Spring 2024 commencement ceremonies. Students who are graduate candidates for the Spring 2024 Term (meaning they have applied for graduation in their MyUMGC by the deadline) are also eligible to participate in commencement. An email will be sent to all eligible graduates and graduate candidates and will include direct links to the RSVP pages. If you think that you are eligible for commencement but have not received an e-mail by March 1, 2024 from UMGC Asia inviting you to RSVP, please contact your local academic advisor or our commencement team. If your completion term was prior to the aforementioned terms or upcoming in the summer of 2024 and you wish to participate in the spring 2024 ceremony, please contact commencement-asia@umgc.edu.

Deadlines

The deadline to submit a graduation application for undergraduate (associate and bachelor's) degree completion is February 15, 2024. Graduate (master's) degree students expecting to complete their programs in Winter or Spring are required to complete their graduation application by April 1, 2024, in order to participate in the 2024 commencement ceremony. If you do not submit a graduation application by the application deadline, you will not receive an invitation to participate in ceremonies and may not be included in the commencement ceremony program book. Should you miss this deadline or do not receive an invitation for commencement, please contact commencement-asia@umgc.edu.

<u>Please note:</u> If you are a Stateside graduate or enrolled in any graduate program other than the Master of Science in Business Administration (MBA) or Master of Science in Transformational Leadership, you

are in a Stateside program and will need to contact commencement-asia@umgc.edu if you wish to participate in Asia's Spring Commencement. Additionally, you will need to complete your application for graduation on or before March 1, 2024 to ensure you receive an invitation to the spring ceremony and are included in the program for the ceremony.
